EYFS Regulation and Relationships - PSED in practice

A workshop for Year R practitioners to explore ways in which they can support children's self-regulation skills, the importance of and how to form positive attachments and how to actively teach children ways to manage their emotions and develop a positive sense of self; all skills which are vital in children's emotional development, which may have been impacted by the pandemic.

(1/2 day)

EYFS The Great Outdoors

This full day, interactive course will support EYFS teachers and leaders to understand the unique benefits of outdoor play. With a range of practical ideas to take away, teachers will explore realistic effective outdoor environments (no matter the size of space available) and how to promote a love of learning outdoors. COURSES

EYFS Diving Deeply into Literacy

A holistic and engaging approach to teaching children to read and write in the EYFS and inspiring a lifelong love of literacy.

Learning to read and write can be a complex, challenging and sometimes baffling experience for young children. It is a holistic process, which draws from the whole Educational Programme, of which phonics is one element. This course will explore how each unique child develops the skills they need to read and write through highly engaging experiences which depend on the critical role of the adult, enabling environment and home partnerships.

EYFS Thinking Creatively, Thinking Critically through Expressive Arts and Design

Creativity and critical thinking are closely interconnected, encouraging the creative process, and thinking outside of the box to explore alternative ideas and solutions.

This practical full day course will look through the lens of the imaginative and critical thinking child to explore the open-ended opportunities that the effective enabling Expressive Arts and Design provision has to offer children to ignite their imagination and innovation.

EYFS Curriculum in Action

This training will support teachers to ensure that the intent of the EYFS curriculum is implemented accordingly considering the following: Curriculum in Action in the Enabling Environment, Curriculum in Action through the Role of the Adult, Curriculum in Action through appropriate experiences. The aim is to develop teacher confidence to implement the school bespoke EYFS curriculum across all aspects of EYFS pedagogy.

An introductory course that looks at key aspects of the EYFS, with a particular focus on the role of the adult in children's learning, an enabling environment and meeting the needs of the unique child.

EYFS Let's Get Fit to Learn in Reception Physical Development

This course explores the how movement can support children's physical development. Through training input and tasks, we will explore how physical play supports children on their journey to becoming confident learners. We will reflect on how provision and routines effectively advance the body and how to support children to become strong and dextrous.

EYFS The Sky's the Limit! Challenge for all

This course examines how the adult can facilitate challenge through effective interactions and a high-quality enabling environment. We consider the importance of high expectations for all children by exploring how every child can be sufficiently challenged through skilfully facilitated learning.

EYFS Tinkering with woodwork

Explore how developing woodwork in the EYFS supports and nurtures a young child's creativity and provides challenge. This course has a focus on the learning process, enabling children to develop strong Characteristics of Effective Teaching and Learning. Explore and use a range of tools. There will also be opportunities to discuss all practicalities of a safe delivery. (all day)

EYFS Mixed, Combined, United

This course provides an opportunity to consider the benefits as well as any potential challenges of having EYFS and Key Stage One within one class. Focus will be given to using the principles of EYFS across the year groups. Discuss key aspects of practice including managing curriculums, providing continuous/enhanced provision for all year groups. (all day)

EYFS Leading the way in Reception

Understanding how to be an Effective Year R Leader

'In this full day course, delegates will develop the skills and knowledge needed to become an effective Year R Leader in action. Covering aspects such as developing your vision, creating a positive and nurturing environment, for children and staff alike, and the purposeful use of assessment. Delegates will gain an understanding of the components needed for successful EYFS leadership.

Sustained shared thinking is a powerful concept in early childhood education that enriches children's learning experiences. This half day course run by the Early Years Advisory Team supports teachers to develop children's thinking, learning and development through sensitive child-centred interactions. We will share a range of tools to help strengthen the Role of the Adult.

EYFS All Aboard! Inclusion in Reception

Explore ways to make your Reception class more inclusive. The course provides practical ideas and suggestions to support children with additional needs and explores how to create an enabling environment, be an inclusive teacher and understand the importance of learning about the unique child.

A focus on good practice for strategic leadership in EYFS as part of a whole school vision. The aim of this training is offer practical and easily implemented strategies to:

This audit tool, for children aged 3-5, supports you in evaluating the quality of practice and provision focussing on the physical environment including children's health and safety; children's relationships and interactions with one another and with significant adults; and the quality of teaching in all areas of learning and development. You will be introduced to how the scales are used to evaluate practice and provision; and will become familiar with key terminology and the different sections of your ECERS3 book. We will examine how the scales can be used to evaluate the role of the adult and the enabling environment.
